Carpenter Foreman Facilities Management Supervisory/Technical – Grade 19 (\$61,363 - \$67,524) 12-month, Full Time

Scope of Responsibilities

The Carpenter Foreman shall maintain all interior and building carpentry-related operations across the district ensuring good appearance and safety. Adapt to changes and emergencies, organize, and supervise all aspects of work performance as related to this trade.

Performance Responsibilities

- 1. Renovate and remodel classrooms, offices, etc., as needed to accommodate staff and students.
- 2. Provide miscellaneous hardware for minor and major repair work, including maintaining equipment in excellent working condition (i.e., blades sharpened, batteries charged, etc.).
- 3. Repair/replacement of shades, drapes, Venetian blinds, etc.
- 4. Maintains lockers, cabinets, shelving, etc., and repairs as needed.
- 5. Constructs/install cabinets, bookcases, countertops, etc.
- 6. Install acoustical ceiling systems, metal/wood framing systems and install and finish drywall.
- 7. Perform concrete and masonry work.
- 8. Window maintenance:
 - a. Repair and reglaze all windows
 - b. Cut glass and Lexan.
 - c. Caulk windows and seal Lexan with silicone.
 - d. Hang mirrors.
 - e. Repair and install window screens, window hardware, locks, etc.

- 9. Provides supervision to department employees, ensuring compliance with all applicable work, rules, policies, and procedures.
- 10. Participate in interviewing, selection, and the evaluation process.
- 11. Responsible for overseeing:
 - a. Department budget,
 - b. Memo purchase orders,
 - c. Estimates of jobs, and
 - d. Work and job schedules.
- 12. Prepare specifications and bidding documents for small-scale projects.
- 13. Coordinates special projects with outside contractors and ensures all work is completed.
- 14. Maintains supplies, materials, and tools to complete the work and transport items to the job site.
- 15. Other work as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications

- 1. Evidence of journeyman certification in carpentry.
- 2. Expertise in woodworking.
- 3. Ten years of experience in carpentry related work.
- 4. Ability to lead workers to accomplish work projects.
- 5. Practical knowledge and experience in carpentry/construction.
- 6. Thorough knowledge of the proper use and application of tools and materials of the trade.
- 7. Ability to work from ladders and scaffolding.
- 8. Ability to adapt in emergency situations.
- 9. Good work and attendance record.
- 10. Willingness to work overtime as required at any time needed in emergencies
- 11. Ability to handle physical requirements of the job: bending, lifting up to 100#, pushing, pulling, climbing, and reaching.

Desirable Qualifications

- 1. Ability to work effectively around students and building staff.
- 2. Be a neat and conscientious self-starter.
