### **Scope of Responsibilities**

3. Assist with various duties at the direction of the assistant principals.
4. Assist building administrators in completing referrals to community agencies.

6. Work positively with existing school programs, students, staff and community agencies.
7. Attend building staff meetings and participates as needed.
8. Performs other duties as assigned.

2. Minimum three years of successful experience working with children and families in diverse/multi-cultural settings.
3. Experience working with secondary at-risk students.
4. Knowledge and experience with community resources and agencies.
