- Develops lessons that are aligned to Mississippi state standards and represent a coherent sequence of learning and reflect collaboration with other school staff within and across disciplines to enrich learning
- Provides lessons that have high levels of learning for all students including appropriate scaffolding that effectively build student understanding, tracks student progress toward mastery, differentiated instruction and relevant connections to students' prior experience or learning opportunities
- Assists students in taking responsibility for learning and monitors student learning by communicating lesson goals, using formative assessments to monitor student progress, giving actionable and timely feedback, provides opportunities for students to self-assess and correct their own errors, and provides opportunities for students to demonstrate what they have learned and how it advances their goals/interests
- Provides multiple ways for students to make meaning of content through various techniques including a variety of explanations and multiple representations of concepts, extended productive discussion, effective question to support students' attainment of the learning goals, making connections to other content across disciplines, and connecting content to real-world applications
- Manages a learning-focused classroom community by creating routines and expectations for students, monitoring student behavior to maximize instructional time,

providing effective collaborative learning opportunities, and providing students an opportunity to take academic leadership roles that promote learning

- Manages classroom space, time and resources (including technology where appropriate) effectively for student learning
- Creates and maintains a classroom of respect for all students
- Engages in professional learning
- Establishes and maintains effective communication with families/community
- Follows Mississippi Code of Ethics and established board policies and procedures
- Demonstrates accuracy in record keeping and promptness in meeting deadlines
- Relates without difficulty to other staff members
- Displays professional behavior (integrity, confidentiality, etc.) exhibiting a commitment to the school and the district both in and out of school
- Is punctual and conscientious in school attendance and participates in school related functions
- Performs all other duties and responsibilities assigned by the principal or assistant principal
