(Students will attend Monday – Thursday from 8:00 AM – 12:00 PM)

Synopsis of Programs: The Elementary and Secondary Summer Learning Programs are for special education eligible students entering 1st through 9th Grade for the 2026-2027 School Year. **Classes will be capped at 10 students per class this year.**

- **LEAP Summer Program (*Learn, Enrich, Achieve, Play*):** For students who currently have self-contained resource room level of support, including those with autism spectrum disorder and/or cognitive impairments and entering 1st through 9th grade for the 2026-2027 school year. Our program focuses on these four core areas:
 - **Learn:** Boosting academic and social development.
 - **Enrich:** Turning student passions into learning opportunities.
 - **Achieve:** Engaging in high-leverage activities with dedicated support.
 - **Play:** Developing the adaptive skills needed for everyday life.

- **E3 Summer Program (*Enrich, Explore, Engage*)** For students who currently have resource room level of support, including those with specific learning disabilities and/or speech and language impairments and entering 1st through 9th grade for the 2026-2027 school year. The program focuses on these three core areas in grade sections 1st -3rd , 4th -5th or 6th -9th .
 - **Enrich:** Strengthening academic skills and social-emotional growth.
 - **Explore:** Connecting personal interests to hands-on learning.
 - **Engage:** Providing high-impact learning opportunities in a supportive environment.

Certification Requirements & Qualifications:

- Valid Michigan Teaching Certificate
- Experience teaching Special Education at Elementary or Secondary levels (*required*)
- Enthusiastic, energetic, and positive professionals
- Experience working with students in individual and group settings to support learning
- Ability to successfully pass a background check

Required Skills:

- Ability to work cooperatively with students, parents, and colleagues
- Effective communication skills, both orally and in writing
- Good organizational and problem-solving skills
