During camp, students strengthen their problem solving, critical thinking, as well as other skills that are needed to be more successful in their future coursework. Students will continue their work with fractions, operations with integers, exploring mathematical relationships, solving equations, and additional areas of study. Camp instructors will provide learning opportunities around the topics listed (as well as others) that align with the NCTM 8 effective practices and the Leander ISD Math Vision.
