PRIMARY PURPOSE

To provide students with a safe, attractive, comfortable, clean and efficient place in which to learn, play and develop.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

- Follow a given schedule to cleans floors, including carpet, ceramic, epoxy, concrete, and VCT throughout school, administration, portable or any ancillary building.
- Maintain an inventory of supplies and equipment required to handle any floor tech assignment.
- Make recommendations for ordering additional supplies as needed.
- Ensure the building is secured during evening hours and energy management and indoor air quality policies are followed.
- Coordinate and assist moving furniture and equipment as required.
- Must be available to assist as a Night Custodian or Day Custodian at a campus, when needed.
- Demonstrates regular and prompt attendance.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

GENERAL QUALIFICATION GUIDELINES

Education/Certification/Experience:

• General experience in custodial or cleaning work.

Knowledge/Skills/Abilities:

- Knowledge of the use, maintenance, and safety of a Trailer Mounted Steam Extractor, in cleaning all
 types of flooring throughout the district including carpet, ceramic, epoxy, concrete, and VCT and on
 how to safely use a propane burnisher, on safe handling of different types of fuels for running
 equipment.
- Skill in the use and placement of blowers to ensure optimal dry time of carpets; use of a high-pressure washer, 2000 psi or higher; trouble shooting and fixing minor repairs related to Trailer Mount Steam Extractor; and use of custodial materials and chemicals.
- Ability to read, understand and follow written and verbal instructions and operate custodial equipment; and read, speak, and write English is strongly preferred.
