PRIMARY PURPOSE

To perform a variety of general duties related to playground maintenance and repairs of district facilities, including playground equipment installations repair, replaces protective surfacing material to help ensure playground areas are safe for age-appropriate users and meet District standards.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

- Notify and request replacement of broken or damaged playscape equipment.
- Recommend general maintenance to appropriate staff.
- Remove trash, rock, grass, and other debris from playscape.
- Operate heavy or specialized equipment such as a bobcat, tractor, operate a variety of hand tools, and transit or sight level.
- Operate various tools and equipment used in the course of work in a clean, orderly, and safe condition.
- Prepare and maintain records, daily inspection form and keep inventory of supplies according to established policies and procedures.
- Report maintenance and repair needs to the grounds supervisor, and campus.
- Assist building maintenance staff, when required, to pull cables, set-up equipment, move heavy ladders/lifts, etc.
- Demonstrates regular and prompt attendance.
- Commute to and from multiple facilities within the District as assigned, using District-owned Vehicle.
- Turn/till mulch routinely especially in high usage areas.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

GENERAL QUALIFICATION GUIDELINES

Education/Certification/Experience:

- General knowledge of maintenance and repair work of equipment for grounds is desired.
- Valid Texas Class "C" Operator's Driver's License. Driving record must meet District standard for driving District vehicles.

Knowledge/Skills/Abilities:

- Knowledge of grounds care; and maintenance work.
- Ability to operate the required equipment to complete the assigned tasks; communicate effectively; and follow instructions.

Mental/Physical/Environmental Demands:

- Ability to understand, remember and apply oral and/or written instructions of other information.

- Constantly positions self to be able to reach items on ground or above head.
- Frequently moves items weighing up to 90 pounds.
- May be exposed to high or low outside temperatures.
- Frequently exposed to intermittent loud noises.
- Noise level in the work environment is usually moderate but will occasionally work in a loud area.
- Work in hot, dry, and dusty conditions as well as possibly cold, wet, and damp areas.
- Will work near or with moving mechanical equipment.
- Occasionally work with grounds or maintenance chemicals.
- Maintain composure and professionalism at all times.
