TITLE: Behaviorist/ Behavior Analyst

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Board Certified Behavioral Analyst (BCBA) certification
2. Valid New Jersey instructional or Educational Services certificate preferred.
3. Successful experience working with children with special needs.
4. Knowledge of diverse needs of children with disabilities.
5. Ability to communicate effectively with students, parents, and school personnel.
6. Required criminal history check and proof of U.S. citizenship or legal resident alien status.
7. Must have a working knowledge of computers.
8. Must have a valid driver's license.
9. Such alternatives to the above qualifications as the Board may find appropriate and acceptable.

REPORTS TO: Director of Special Education

JOB GOAL: To support the district's instructional program by facilitating students' attainment of social and emotional growth consistent with the goals set forth by the individual education plans (IEP).

SUPERVISES: None

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Works district-wide to support students with behavioral and/or social-emotional needs.
2. Reports to, and consults with, the Director of Special Education on an ongoing basis.
3. Consults and collaborates with the Child Study Team on an ongoing basis.
4. Schedules regularly consultations with classroom teachers.

19. Performs additional responsibilities as identified with the Director of Special Education.
20. Attends evening programs (i.e., Back to School Nights, ABA workshops) annually.
21. Carries out job responsibilities in a professional manner.
22. Carries out such other professional duties as may be assigned by the Superintendent and/or his/her designee.
