JOB GOAL:

To provide leadership in the development and improvement of

the sport program by developing athletes' knowledge, skills,

sportsmanship, and motivation to excel.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Assists the Head Coach in the preparation and supervision of individual participants in the skills necessary for success in the sport involved.
- 2. Assists the athletic director and head coach in making arrangements for athletic competitions and related transportation, if so assigned. While going to and from games, assists in maintaining good order.
- 3. Assumes responsibility for team members under his/her supervision; promotes good sportsmanship and enforces all rules and regulations. Complies with board-adopted emergency medical procedures for all practice sessions and competitive levels.
- 4. Attends all practices and contests of the assigned sport. Assists at contests in observing play and devising strategies to improve the performance of the team and the players.
- 5. Oversees any assigned area of focus such as offense, defense, goalie or transition game giving due consideration to the safety conditions of the facility or area in which the assigned activity is conducted at all times that students are present.
- 6. Assists in the distribution and collection of athletic gear.

- 7. Assists in upholding and enforcing school rules, administrative regulations and board policy and all NJSIAA rules and regulations governing sports.
- 8. Is prepared to take over full coaching duties in the event the head coach is absent or becomes ill.
- 9. Assists the head coach in being responsible for seeing that all participants have transportation home when returning from road trips in late evening hours.
- 10. Assists potential collegiate athletes in signing up for the NCAA clearing house and in obtaining sports-related college admission and/or scholarships.
- 11. Performs other duties which may be within the scope of his/her employment and certification as may be assigned.
