Duties & Responsibilities			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Assess student athlete’s skills and assign team positions</li><li>• Develop a regular practice schedule and organize practice time to provide both individual and team development</li><li>• Follow the guidance of the district strength coach to set up a conditioning program</li><li>• Work with the Athletic Director in scheduling facilities for practices and competition</li><li>• Work with the Athletic Director to determine program needs and monitor budget/expenses</li><li>• Coach and instruct players, individually and in groups, regarding the rules, regulations, equipment, and techniques of the sport</li><li>• Observe players during competition and practice to determine the needs for individual or team improvement</li><li>• Determine game strategy based on the team's capabilities</li><li>• Monitor individual/team stats throughout the season and postseason and advise players on how to improve</li><li>• Establish and maintain standards of decorum and provide proper supervision of athletes at all times</li><li>• Monitor the academic performance of team members to ensure that eligibility requirements are met and encourage student-athletes to maintain a high academic standard</li><li>• Follow established procedures in the event of an athlete's injury</li><li>• Conference with parents/guardians, as necessary, regarding the athletic performance of their student</li><li>• Follow state, regional, and district regulations governing the athletic program</li><li>• Model sports-like behavior and maintain appropriate conduct towards players, officials, and spectators</li><li>• Act as a team representative and promote the sport by communicating with booster clubs, service clubs, community groups, and other organizations</li><li>• Follow established procedures for the proper care, maintenance, and requisitioning of equipment, supplies, and uniforms</li><li>• Work with the Athletic Director to develop a policy for awards and submits a list of award winners at the end of the season</li><li>• Participate in special activities to include fundraising, parent's night, banquets, award nights, and pep assemblies</li><li>• Maintain eligibility forms, emergency data cards, insurance records, equipment inventory, and other related records</li><li>• Model non-discriminatory practices in all activities</li><li>• Attend staff development meetings, clinics, and other professional activities to improve coaching performance</li><li>• Complete any Safe School courses recommended and assigned by the Athletic Director</li><li>• Perform any other related duties as assigned by the administration</li></ul>
