**POSITION SUMMARY:** The JV Baseball Coach is responsible for teaching fundamental skills, fostering sportsmanship, and preparing student athletes for advancement to the varsity level while promoting academic achievement and personal growth.

**DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:** *other duties may be assigned*

- Plan, organize, and conduct regular practices that develop player skills, knowledge of the game, and teamwork
- Teach and reinforce fundamental techniques such as hitting, pitching, fielding, base running, and game strategies
- Promote a positive, respectful, and safe environment for all athletes
- Collaborate with the varsity baseball coach to ensure consistency in coaching philosophy, training methods, and program goals
- Evaluate player skills and provide constructive feedback to promote improvement
- Supervise athletes before, during, and after practices, games, and team events
- Manage game-day responsibilities, including lineup preparation, in-game adjustments, and sportsmanship
- Maintain communication with players, parents, athletic trainer, and athletic director
- Enforce all school, league, and state athletic rules and policies
- Support the academic success of all student athletes
- Oversee care and accountability of uniforms, equipment, and facilities
- Commitment to regular and predictable attendance
- Adherence to Greenville Public Schools core values: integrity, collaboration, compassion, and responsibility
