**Basic Function**: To educate the students of the District using approved curriculum.

### **Essential Functions:**

- 1. Teach reading, language arts, social studies, mathematics, science, art, health, physical education, career and technical courses, and/or music to pupils in a classroom as appropriate to grade level / building level, using the course of study adopted by the Board of Education and other appropriate learning activities.
- 2. Prepare course objectives and outline for course of study following curriculum guidelines or requirements of state and school.
- 3. Develop lesson plans and instructional materials and provide individualized and small group instruction in order to adapt the curriculum to the needs of each pupil.
- 4. Establish and maintain standards of pupil behavior needed to achieve a functional learning atmosphere in the classroom.
- 5. Communicate with parents through conferences and other means to discuss pupil's progress and interpret the school program.
- 6. Identify pupil needs and cooperate with other professional staff members in assessing and helping pupils solve health, attitude, and learning problems.
- 7. Maintain professional competence through in-service education activities provided by the district and self-selected professional growth activities.
- 8. Supervise pupils during the assigned working day.
- 9. Administer group-standardized tests in accordance with district testing program.
- 10. Participate in curriculum development programs as required.

- 11. Keep and maintain attendance and grade records as required by school.
- 12. Other duties as assigned.

#### Specifications/Qualifications:

Possess or be able to acquire valid lowa teaching license, authorization or endorsement

## **Physical Requirements:**

May be required to lift up to 20 pounds.

## **Working Conditions:**

Generally work indoors, but may be required to work out-of-doors. May included hot conditions depending on local weather conditions. All classrooms are heated. High School classrooms are climate controlled. Some other classrooms throughout the District are climate controlled.
