Lawrence North High School is looking for applicants with a strong background in wrestling for assistant coaching positions. This is a program that has produced four IHSAA state championships, three IHSAA runner-up finishes, one IHSWCA state title, and numerous team and individual county, conference, sectional, regional, semi-state, and state championships.

Lawrence North has an enrollment of approximately 2850 students and is a member of the MIC conference, one of the most athletic and academic conferences in the state. LN has a brand new dedicated wrestling room with a cardio room located right next to the wrestling room and a state of the art weight room with a full-time weight training coach.

Previous coaching and wrestling experience is required. This position involves building positive relationships with student-athletes and teaching life lessons through the sport of wrestling. The assistant coach will help prepare and implement practice and match plans. The coach will supervise, instruct, and advise athletes during practices and matches stressing teamwork, competitiveness and sportsmanship. The coach will be expected to assist with communicating effectively with athletes, parents, and school personnel. The high school coaching staff will be expected to be involved in the development of the sport of wrestling at the middle school level and feeder systems in the Lawrence Community.
