Performance Responsibilities:

1. Serve as and complete all responsibilities as Teacher of Record (TOR) for students challenging behaviors with a variety of eligibilities
2. Provides a socially/emotional safe environment in which prosocial behaviors are taught, modeled, and reinforced using research based practices and techniques
3. Uses a variety of data collection tools to identify function of behavior and teacher replacement behaviors
4. Incorporates specifically designed instruction to create academics and social/emotional lessons aligned with state standards
5. Completes Non-Violent Crisis Intervention training, and participate in recertification
6. Demonstrates strong and effective managing, organization, communication, and work habit skills in all settings
7. Strong understanding of Article 7 and IDEA by writing and implementing compliant IEP's, FBA, and BIP's.
8. Communicates daily with general education staff, related service provides, and support staff
9. Promotes and advocates for students to have an inclusive and equitable education
10. Performs other assigned duties from school leaders as requested

11. In the event of extended school closure or E-Learning day, participate in 1-1 or small group virtual services, frequent communication with parents/guardians, providing modified curriculum, meeting weekly with school team, etc.
