

Ability to effectively teach and communicate technical concepts to student learners. Teaching experience is highly recommended. Hold a current HeartSaver with AED CPR certification.

Position Purpose / Description

- The teacher is responsible for teaching groups of students in a classroom/lab setting, based on a curriculum and supported by instructional materials.

Essential Functions

- The teacher is responsible for developing daily lesson plans to ensure that the teacher covers the curricular content in a timely manner through the semester or school year.
- The teacher uses various instructional methods and techniques to meet the unique needs of the individual students and assess their learning.
- The teacher modifies instruction, re-teaches and remediates to ensure the students' success.

Additional Duties

- The teacher is responsible for monitoring, promoting, and supporting Career-Technical Education by assisting with marketing and public relations as assigned.
- The teacher will provide daily hall supervision prior to class start and after class dismissal
