- Assist with recruitment and coordination of student players for the program
- Complete academic games programming trainings as required
- Complete appropriate AGLOA paperwork
- Manage learning resources and games materials
- Instruct players in the rules and regulations, game play, strategy, scoring, etc. Ensure compliance.
- Coordinate, prepare for, and supervise practice sessions
- Model good sportsmanship and fair play
- Perform tasks as assigned, related to communications, schedules, practices, competitions, etc.
- Assist with fund-raising as needed and assigned; handle funds according to district policies and protocols
- Supervise and direct students
- Perform other duties related to the program as assigned by the High School Principal and Academic Games Head Sponsor
