WORKING CONDITIONS:

Mental Demands/Physical Demands/Environmental Factors:

On call 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Continual walking, standing, climbing, stooping, bending, reaching, heavy lifting, and carrying. Ability to lift and transport 70 pounds a distance of ten feet without assistance. Work in tiring and uncomfortable positions, around electrical power lines, outside and inside. Exposure to extreme temperatures. Frequent district-wide travel.

Essential Functions:

- 1. Diagnose and make all necessary electrical repairs and installations of school facilities.
- 2. Assist in all necessary repairs to grounds, building, and equipment.
- 3. Assist with new construction and renovations, as required.
- 4. Establish and maintain an efficient and effective system of routine and preventative maintenance.
- 5. Promote, follow and maintain high standards/practices of safety and good housekeeping in all working conditions.
- 6. Measure, assemble, and install electrical conduit using measuring devices, hand tools, pipe threader, and conduit bender.
- 7. Receive and complete work orders in a timely manner. Select material and hardware and calculate time and materials estimates.
- 8. Maintain accurate records on material and labor.
