PACK Pride is omnipresent at New Fairfield Middle School. PACK—Pride, Attitude, Commitment, Keep It Safe. These are our core values, and are integral to our success. Our school community includes approximately 685 students and 80 staff members. Students are grouped heterogeneously into two teams at each the three grade levels, 6-8.

New Fairfield Middle School provides a rigorous academic program. Beginning in 2012, a one-to-one computing innovation was begun in grade 6. Every sixth grade student has access to a computer for use each day. Beginning in September, all seventh and eighth grade students will have access to a netbook for use at home and school. All students take science, social studies, math, reading, and writing daily. Sixth graders are off team two periods per day, during which time they participate in the following classes: world language, library/media, computer applications, physical education, developmental guidance, art, music/band, and health. In seventh and eighth grades, students take short-term classes in physical education, art, music/band, and health, and they take a full period class in French. Spanish, or Computer Applications.

Learning specialists, counselors, a social worker, a psychologist, and paraprofessionals offer a wide variety of support services to students when needed. Our PTO and many interested, involved parents help us provide a variety of enrichment experiences every year. Enrichment experiences can include intramurals, clubs, dances, activity nights, field trips, and inschool assemblies.

Each of our students creates, and updates yearly, a Student Success Plan using the Naviance web-based program. Students set academic and personal goals, explore their interests and strengths, and then investigate career options that complement those interests and strengths. We have grown exponentially in our uses of technology to support instruction in the past few years and are striving to become a technology-savvy village of learners.

This school year also marks our implementation of Positive Behavioral Interventions and Support (PBIS), recognizing students for meeting stated behavioral expectations at school. Look for PACK pride throughout our school.
