This role requires a strong understanding of flag football fundamentals, a commitment to positive youth development, and the ability to inspire and mentor young athletes in a fun and supportive environment.

Major Duties and Responsibilities

- Lead, plan, and execute all practices and team activities for the Berkshire Middle School Flag Football team at Berkshire Middle School fields.
- Develop and implement strategies for individual player skill development and overall team performance.
- Oversee all games, including lineup decisions, on-field coaching, and ensuring fair play and sportsmanship.
- Supervise student-athletes at all times during practices, games, and team-related activities, ensuring their safety and well-being.
- Foster a positive, inclusive, and supportive team culture that emphasizes skill development, teamwork, and character.
- Communicate effectively and regularly with student-athletes, parents, the Athletic Director, and opposing coaches.

- Manage team equipment and uniforms in coordination with the Athletic Department.
- Adhere to all Berkshire Middle School and athletic department policies and procedures, including eligibility rules.
- Promote academic success, responsible behavior, and healthy lifestyles among student-athletes.
- Work collaboratively with the Athletic Director on scheduling, budgeting, and program development.

Qualifications

- Proven experience playing or coaching flag football or traditional football, preferable at the youth or middle school level. Prior coaching experience is a plus.
- Strong knowledge of flag football rules, strategies, and techniques.
- Exceptional leadership, communication, and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to motivate, mentor, and build strong relationships with young athletes.
- Demonstrated commitment to the principles of sportsmanship, ethical conduct, and positive youth development.
- Must be able to pass a background check as required by school policy.
- CPR/First Aid certification (or willingness to obtain before the start of the season).
