RESPONSIBILITIES:

Teacher activities shall include but not be limited to:

- 1. Working with students, ages 18-26, who have disabilities and their families to provide:
 - a) Direct pupil support.
 - b) Academic, pre-vocational, vocational instruction/curriculum for each student.
 - c) Creating and implementing Behavior Intervention Plans/Functional Behavior Assessments.
 - d) Family consultation.
 - e) Consultation with the general education teachers which may include:
 - 1. Student monitoring.
 - 2. Providing materials.
 - 3. Individualizing teaching methods.
 - 4. Team teaching.
- 2. Attend and facilitate case studies and Individualized Educational Planning Committee meetings.
- 3. Fully, independently, and accurately implement the requirements of IDEA and Michigan's Special Education Rules for students.
- 4. Provide educational observation and evaluation for students suspected of having a disability.
- 5. Participate in Child Study upon request.
- 6. Maintain contact with appropriate service agencies and community support.
- 7. Work cooperatively as a team member with paraeducator(s), support staff, teacher-consultant(s), and general education teachers.
- 8. Provide guidance and counseling concerning social and emotional growth in the academic setting.
- 9. Perform other such duties as assigned by the Principal and/or Director of Special Services.
