- Documentation of injuries and treatment including required MHSAA Concussion Reporting.
- Carries out appropriate instructions, treatment and rehabilitation as directed by the supervising physician.
- Assists and advises coaches in the appropriate fit and use of safety equipment.
- Responsible for the organization, inventory, and requisition (through the AD) of training room supplies.

- Must be present at all designated games and practices.
- Other related duties and responsibilities as assigned by the athletic director or principal.
