Position Summary

The nursery coordinator is responsible for providing childcare in a safe environment for the children of PACT Charter School volunteers who are helping at the Elementary Campus.

Areas of Responsibility

Basic Duties and Responsibilities

- Provides a safe, clean, and inviting environment for all PACT Charter School's volunteer children.
- Interacts with children and encourages their involvement in activities.
- Organizes, leads, and participates in games; reads to children; and teaches them simple painting, drawing, songs, and similar activities.
- Helps children remove outer garments upon arriving at nursery and helps them to develop habits of caring for their own clothing through hanging up garments and keeping them organized.
- Helps children develop habits of putting away toys and books.
- Directs children in proper eating habits and encourages proper hygiene.
- Directs children in toileting. Notifies parents/guardians if the child needs diapering.
- Assists children in learning how to care for others and learn to share.
- Reinforces positive behavior.
- Supervises the safety and maintenance of the nursery.
- Coordinates staffing needs and nursery use with the Volunteer and Events Coordinator.
- Establishes and maintains communication with the parents/guardians and informs them how their child responds to other children and the Nursery Coordinator.
- Ensures that the nursery and all toys in it are properly cleaned after each day and whenever necessary to prevent the spread of germs between children.
