Competitive Pay

- Pattonville School District has a highly competitive salary structure. For the 2016-17 school year, full-time bus drivers start out between \$13.50 - \$14.59 per hour and can earn up to \$22.02 per hour.



- Full-time bus drivers (20+ hour per week) are guaranteed 4 to 5.5 hours per day.
- Substitute bus driver opportunities are available for individuals available in the a.m. only, p.m. only, or on specific days of the week. We will work around your school or work schedule!

Generous Benefits Package

- Bus drivers that consistently work over 20 hour per week are considered full-time. Full-time bus drivers receive over \$9,500 in annual insurance benefits. Standard benefits include health insurance, dental insurance, and life insurance.



- Tuition assistance is available to provide financial support to help bus drivers pay for university coursework.



A Great Place to Work

- Bus drivers work in safe, well equipped modern school buses.
- Pattonville School bus drivers participate in ongoing compensated driver education and safety training.
- Bus drivers earn paid vacation and accrue paid sick leave. The district has provisions to purchase unused sick and vacation time after specific thresholds.
- Bus drivers that consistently work 20 or more hours per week (full-time) earn credit towards retirement in the Missouri Public School Employee Retirement System (PEERS). Peers provides lifetime retirement benefits for qualified MO school employees.
- The Pattonville School District earned a 2015 Top Workplaces Award from the St. Louis Post-Dispatch. The district was ranked No. 14 among the Top 20 large companies in the St. Louis area with 500 or more employees.

High Performing

Pattonville High School was named among the top high schools in Missouri and the nation on U.S. News and World Report's 2015 Best High Schools ranking. Pattonville earned a bronze medal in this year's rankings. Based on U.S. News and World Report's methodology, Pattonville's results placed it at No. 30 out of 533 high schools in Missouri (the Top 6 percent in the state). This is the second time Pattonville earned a spot on U.S. News and World Report's Top High Schools list.
