The responsibilities for this position will require the TA to work with students with a wide range of English language proficiency from "Newcomers" to students transitioning from English language supports.

General Responsibilities

The ESOL TA Will:

- 1.) Provide support within the regular classroom including, but not limited to:
 - Assisting teachers with providing needed accommodations and/or modifications including those needed for standardized assessments
 - Supporting individual student needs to ensure language and content knowledge acquisition
 - Increasing student independence with navigating schedule, building, and social situations.
 - Collect data to help monitor student progress toward goals for language, academic, and social development
- 2.) Support students within the EL classroom including, but not limited to:
 - Help EL specialist manage student schedules and assist with student transitions
 - Monitor and support student work and learning while EL Specialist works with individual or small groups of students.
 - Assist with screening and annual ACCESS testing as needed
- 3.) Will attend professional development and department meetings when applicable.
- 4.) Other duties as assigned
