 - Concussion Management Training
- Current First Aid/CPR/AED certification, or ability to obtain prior to season start
- Commitment to sportsmanship, academic success, and personal growth of athletes
- Excellent communication, organizational, and interpersonal skills
- Ability to maintain student confidentiality and follow all district and WIAA policies
- Must uphold Port Angeles High School's coaching expectations around preparation, integrity, and community engagement
- Attendance and punctuality are essential
