 - 2) IHSA State Test
 - 3) Sport First Aid
- Coaching experience in the particular sport is preferred (High School - Varsity level or higher)
- Playing experience in the particular sport is preferred (High School - Varsity level or higher)
- Ability to communicate (written/verbal), make decisions, resolve conflict, and effectively work with staff, students and other stakeholders to develop a successful program

Key Accountabilities:

- Overall administration and supervision of the program at all levels
- Responsible for the welfare and safety of all athletes in the program
- Assign all duties to assistant coaches working in the program
- Develop and organize all activities related to program in-season and off-season
- General upkeep and protection of equipment for the program
- Complete an inventory of the equipment used for the sport; (to be completed at the end of each season)
- Recommend purchase of equipment, supplies, and uniforms as need demands
- Work closely with the Assistant Principal of Athletics in scheduling interscholastic contests
- Stay up-to-date with the current knowledge and trends in the sport
- Receive CPR/AED certification and maintain accordingly
- Ensure all of the participants are eligible for participation
- Responsible for:
 - Parent communication
 - Relationship with Booster Club, PTO, and/or Community Organization(s)
 - Communicating with all stakeholders to grow and sustain a successful program
- Meet and follow all compliance obligations set forth by the Conference Calendar, RBHS Coaches Handbook, and IHSA
- Attend all events or meetings that are required by the Assistant Principal of Athletics

- Perform other duties as assigned by Assistant Principal of Athletics or Principal
