

JOB DESCRIPTION

HEAD FLAG FOOTBALL COACH

This position is responsible for coaching and providing direction to student athletes so they may achieve a high level of skill as well as an appreciation for discipline, sportsmanship and teamwork in flag football.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Hold a valid First Aid, CPR Adult & Child certification, and AED card. Certification must be obtained from a "hands-on" class (rather than online) in order to comply with Renton School District policies and procedures.
- 2. Minimum 21 years of age for head coach and 19 years of age for assistant coach.
- 3. Demonstrated working knowledge of the above-mentioned sport. Coaching experience preferred.
- 4. Demonstrated interest in and ability to work well with multicultural high school students, staff and community.
- 5. Such alternative and/or additional requirements as the district may find appropriate and acceptable.
- 6. High School diploma or equivalent.

JOB DUTIES

- Attend meetings as required by Renton School District, league, or affiliated entity.
- Actively monitor and enforce the eligibility of student-athletes in Final Forms
- Coach student athletes including coaching at all team practices and scheduled games/ competitions
- Perform secondary administrative or coaching duties within the program
- Handling game and practice coaching assignments throughout the year
- Fundraising for the program under District Guidelines
- Maintain District policies
- Planning scheduled contests with Athletic Manager

- Gameday roster
- Evaluate assistant coaches and unpaid volunteers
- Ensure the safety of students.
- Finding appropriate meetings and venues
- Communication with students per District policy
- Lead instruction, preparation for competition, and manage all personnel decisions for the program at all levels.
- Ensure effective supervision of students at all required times including locker rooms, bus travel, and during all scheduled team activities.
- Develop and document daily practice plans.
- Coordinate the finances and fundraising activities of the program in collaboration with the school athletic director, ASB, and other school staff in accordance with RSD policies and procedures.
- Manage program inventory, storage, and ensure proper condition of equipment
- Develop and maintain a team handbook that informs families of rules that are specific to the team, outside of the published RSD and WIAA rules.
- Work with, advise, and communicate regularly with booster clubs.
- Supervise and evaluate assistant coaching staff.
- Maintain required coaching certifications as required by Renton School District and the WIAA.
- Ensure program compliance with RSD policies and procedures and WIAA rules.
- Communicate important information with families regularly.
- Assists the Athletic Director in the coordination of scheduling events for the sport (usually non-league contests and tournaments).
- Is responsible for the appropriate use of school facilities and property.

NOTE:

- All district coaches are required to complete all online WIAA rules clinic prior to their first practice.
- Completion of all mandatory training and obtaining all necessary certifications is required prior to coaching practices, without exception.
- All district coaches are required to actively participate in the WIAA Coaches Standards Program every three (3) years per WIAA standards.
- This position is open to all individuals, including current employees.
