3. Demonstrated strong group process and collaboration skills.
4. Flexibility and the willingness to adapt to schedule changes.
5. Ability to differentiate and individualize instruction.
6. Experience utilizing student data to drive instruction.
7. Demonstrated oral and written fluency in English.
8. Ability to mentor staff in the development of instructional programs and strategies.
9. Experience in the implementation of authentic assessment tools and strategies.
10. Ability to write reports, correspondence, and procedure manuals.
11. Ability to establish and maintain effective relationships with students, peers, and parents of diverse ethnic, cultural, and socioeconomic backgrounds.
12. Willingness to learn new skills and acquire new knowledge.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Plan, prepare, and deliver lessons in one-on-one and small group settings.
2. Provide supplemental services to eligible students (push-in and pull-out) in multiple district buildings.
3. Collaborate with general education teachers to support students in the content areas.
4. Utilize educational software and websites to support language acquisition.
5. Maintain, organize, and inventory learning materials.
6. Prepare appropriate documentation and reports.
7. Familiarize newcomer students with American culture and school expectations.
8. Support EL families in communicating with the schools and serve as an advocate.
9. Administer the WIDA screener and annual test to students.
10. Monitor student progress toward achieving instructional objectives and goals.
11. Coach and model effective methods, techniques, and strategies, including SIOP.
12. Plan and provide professional learning to support the school improvement plan.
13. Attend district, county, and state meetings related to EL's and Title III and participate in ongoing professional development opportunities.
14. Review, recommend, and support the integration of technology, materials, and appropriate instructional resources for ELs.
15. Other duties as assigned.
