

**POSITION:** POHI 18-26 year old Transition Lab Teacher

2. Have experience of working with students with special needs 18-26 years old.

6. Assume responsibility for convening post updates and attending all IEPC's within appropriate timelines for all assigned students.
7. Write goals and objectives for each student as mandated by Federal, State and County agencies.
8. Provide input to building administrators and/or POHI TC's regarding appropriate classes for mainstreaming of POHI students.
9. Create community contacts with local businesses and workplaces, and work with those individuals in finding employment and/or work experience opportunities for our POHI students.
