CURRICULUM

- Provides instructional leadership and supervision
- Serves as administrative facilitator of the Instructional Curriculum Council
- Facilitates the ICC textbook and new course review processes
- Purchases classroom subscriptions and facilitator for operation in cooperation with tech department
- Initiating and assisting with professional staff development
- Works with Personnel Director on development and implementation of teacher and instructional support staff evaluations
- Works with Special Education Director on MTSS Process, regularly attends data dives

- Works with principals to ensure Atlas Rubicon Curriculum Mapping software is up to date DISTRICT ASSESSMENT COORDINATOR
- District Coordinator for national, state and local assessments (e.g. M-Step, FastBridge, eduCLIMBER, WIDA, NWEA, MiStar DNA, NSGA and various literacy tests)
- District Coordinator for the BAA Secure Site
- Assisting school staff analyze assessment data and present to board and community stakeholders multiple times a year

SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT

- Serves as the District Coordinator for the District Improvement Plan and Cognia
- Provides technical assistance to school improvement teams
- Serves as the lead district person in the accreditation process, including peer review visits
