Job Summary: The Academic Interventionist will provide academic interventions under teacher supervision. The successful candidate will provide individual and small group instruction to at-risk students identified through MTSS.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- REQUIRED: Associates degree or 60 hours of college credit; BA or BS and teaching experience (preferred)
- Experience working with students in groups and individually.
- Basic computer knowledge and skills.
- Ability to carry out all assignments given by teachers and the building administrator.

- Ability to be flexible, to work independently, and to contribute as a member of a team.
- Ability to prioritize tasks, allocate time, and maintain schedule flexibility.
