POSITION SUMMARY INFORMATION: Essential Duties and Requirement Details

Under direct supervision of the principal, AVID coordinator and with the assistance of the AVID elective teacher, tutors will work with AVID students in study groups and individually, assisting them in all academic areas to make progress commensurate with college expectations.

Essential Functions and Responsibilities:

- Take an active role in developing the academic and personal strengths of AVID students
- Serve as a role model/mentor to AVID students by being a lifelong learner, demonstrating appropriate academic and social behaviors, and wearing appropriate attire at all times
- Determine from student's notes and discussions, the concepts that need to be taught or retaught
- Evaluate student binders, including calendars, class and textbook notes, etc.
- Become familiar with the materials in the AVID Curriculum Libraries
- Become familiar with the textbooks and materials used by AVID students
- Become familiar and utilize the 10-step AVID Tutorial process
- Conduct tutorial sessions in all content areas
- Work with students in any phase of the writing process, such as brainstorming, clustering, revision, and editing
- Communicate frequently and honestly with the AVID coordinator/teacher regarding student progress and areas of concern
- Meet regularly to discuss student progress and to confer with the teacher about future tutorial plans.
