JOB DESCRIPTION

READING TUTOR (NON-CERTIFIED): PART-TIME

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Bachelor's degree.
- Connecticut teaching certification preferred.
- Work habits exemplify teamwork, productivity, initiative, organization, and flexibility.
- Ability to communicate effectively.
- Ability to relate to school-age children enrolled in the district.
- Ability to take direction from and work under the supervision of one or more teachers.
- Proficient use of technology, copiers, equipment, etc.

REPORTS TO:

Teachers, central office administrators (i.e., Language Arts Coordinator), building administrator, or other assigned administrator.

JOB GOAL:

To assist teachers in lesson preparation and delivery through one-to-one or small group tutoring.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Assembles and prepares instructional materials.
2. Prepares and implements lessons in keeping with the district curricula and based on the individual student's needs as appropriate.
3. Communicates regularly with the teacher(s) regarding the student's progress and assessments.
4. Works with individual students or small groups to reinforce learning of strategies or skills.
5. Administers, scores, and records assessments.
6. Alerts the teacher and/or administrator to any concerns or important information about individual students.
7. Serves as the primary source of information and assists in the teacher's absence.
8. Maintains a high level of ethical behavior and confidentiality with information about students.
9. Participates in professional development training.
10. All other duties as deemed appropriate by the administrator.

Work in standard classroom and school building environments.

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT:

10-months, part-time, hourly, not to exceed twenty (20) hours per week. Weekly work schedule to be determined based on school and district needs.
