Job Goal: The primary goal of the Autism Teacher is to provide specialized instruction in an individualized program for students in order to empower them to become happy, confident and productive members of their community.

Qualifications:

- 1. Minimum Bachelor's Degree in special education, minimum of 2 years teaching experience, and experience working with students with Autism.
- 2. LBS1 unlimited (K-9) required
- 3. Must have experience working with a large team of professionals, and be flexible

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Design, supervise and implement students' IEP plans
- 2. Create and coordinate student schedules with related services and general education
- 3. Collect and analyze student data and monitor student progress
- 4. Effectively work with large team of professionals needs to coordinate services
- 5. Participate in several staff development trainings that focus on working with students with Autism
- 6. Implement state of the art strategies to work effectively with students with Autism
- 7. Participate in students' staffing throughout the year
- 8. Must have no physical limitations. Candidate must be able to lift. He/She must be able to participate in the MENTA model of physical restraint.
