SAU #6 Director of Special Education Job Description

Job Responsibilities include:

Communication & Educational Programming:

- 1. Oversee and direct the special education and 504 educational services of SAU #6.
- 2. Monitor and evaluate the efficacy of special education programs and services.
- 3. Coordinate transportation as required by IEPs and 504 plans.
- 4. Coordinate connections between families and community agencies.
- 5. Attend School Board meetings and other team/committee meetings as needed.
- 6. Serve as contact with the NH DOE special education consultants.
- 7. Other responsibilities as directed by the Superintendent.

Staff Supervision & Professional Development:

- 8. Supervise special education district and SAU-level staff (i.e., administrative assistant, out-of-district case manager, Medicaid clerk, contracted related service providers, etc.)
- 9. Share supervision of school-based special education staff with building principals.
- 10. Maintain appropriate levels of staffing to ensure compliance with all laws and regulations regarding IDEA and 504.
- 11. Provide and coordinate professional development for special and general education instructional, support, and administrative staff on special education and 504 topics.

Finances & Contracts:

- 12. Develop and monitor special education budgets, including writing and reporting in the NH DOE online grants management system.
- 13. Negotiate and monitor contracts with related service providers.

Compliance & Reporting:

- 14. Complete required state reporting for special education and 504 programs.
- 15. Direct and address legal matters pertaining to students receiving or in the process of receiving special education and 504 services.
- 16. Advise and consult with all SAU #6 staff regarding educational and legal issues in the areas of special education and 504.
