- 3. Aid in grading clinical documents that each graduating student has achieved the desired level of competence prior to graduation.
- 4. Participate as a preceptor in aiding students to clinical sites, including lab tours and demonstrations.
- 5. Orients clinical personnel in achieving program objectives.
- 6. Teach EMS courses.
