Summary: The Maintenance Worker performs a variety of skilled and semiskilled tasks in the maintenance, repair and upkeep of district buildings, grounds, and equipment to ensure a safe, clean and functional learning environment for students, staff and visitors.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

	Perform routine maintenance and repairs on HVAC, electrical, plumbing, and mechanical systems.
	Inspect school facilities regularly to identify safety or maintenance issues and report them to the supervisor.
	Complete minor carpentry, painting, and drywall repair projects.
	Assist with the maintenance of school grounds, including landscaping, snow removal, and litter pickup.
	Set up and take down furniture and equipment for school events or facility use.
	Respond to work orders and emergencies in a timely and professional manner.
	Assist with inspections and compliance with safety codes and building regulations.
	Maintain accurate records of maintenance work, supplies used, and equipment serviced.

	Collaborate with custodial staff, contractors, and other maintenance personnel.
	Ensure secure storage and proper use of tools, supplies, and equipment.
	Support energy conservation and sustainability efforts where applicable.

	Upholds and adheres to safety rules and policies of the district.
	Supports the goals and objectives of the school district and follows all district policies.
	Demonstrates the ability to attend work on a regular and routine basis to avoid disruption to district operations.
	Perform any other duties assigned by the Building Administrator/Immediate Supervisor.

	Two (2) years of maintenance or facilities experience preferred, especially in a school or institutional setting, is preferred.
