JOB SUMMARY:

The School Crossing Guard is responsible for ensuring the safe passage of students and pedestrians at designated school crossings. The position requires vigilant monitoring of traffic conditions and pedestrian behavior, while maintaining a calm, professional demeanor and adhering to district safety procedures. This individual plays a critical role in fostering a safe school environment by managing traffic and assisting children in safely crossing roadways during peak school travel times.

ESSENTIAL TASKS:

- Perform all duties professionally and courteously while interacting with students, staff, and the public.
- Arrive promptly and reliably at assigned posts, demonstrating independence and responsibility.
- Follow and enforce safety procedures and district protocols with a strong emphasis on student and public welfare.
- Direct students to cross streets safely at designated crossing points or signals.
- Regulate and manage vehicular traffic when necessary to ensure the safety of students and pedestrians.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Maintenance Supervisor.

Must be able to reach above and below the waist, walk and use fingers to pick, feel and grasp objects. Requires use of both hands for repetitive motion. Some bending and twisting of the body required. Lifts/carries supplies and papers weighing no more than 40 lbs. Typical office environment with the ability to sit eighty percent (80%) of workday.
