SUMMER JOB

WAREHOUSE/DELIVERY DRIVER

This posting is for the **FS CENTRAL FACILITY WORKER POSITION** (WAREHOUSE/DRIVER POSITION) for the 2019 Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) funded by the USDA. The SFSP will begin Tuesday, May 28, 2019 with the opening of high school sites, but the majority of programs will begin Monday, June 3, 2019. A majority of the programs are scheduled to end Friday, June 28, 2019. Employment may begin a few days before program begins and extend for a few days after program ends. The length of employment, as well as the number of hours per day will vary depending upon program participation. Additional time will be required to attend a paid mandatory training session prior to the start of the program. Each employee will be assigned to attend one of these sessions. The number of positions may vary.

POSITION DESCRIPTIONS:

Warehouse/Delivery Driver: Responsible for the delivery of food and supplies to Summer Food Service Program sites, receiving and issuing of product at the F.S. Central Warehouse. May assist in routing of food and supplies. Reports to Warehouse Supervisor.

Minimum Qualifications: **Must be currently employed as a TUSD Food Service Delivery Driver or Warehouse Tech.** (D.O.T, Medical card and Central Kitchen physical are required for these positions) SFSP experience preferred. Selection will be based on attendance histories during the regular school year and any previous summer work, availability to work the entire program and job performance during the regular school year and any previous summer work evaluations.
