SUMMARY
The Classified Enrichment Instructor provides program enrichment classes in a non-core subject such as pottery, cooking, photography, chess, or life skills.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS
Knowledge/experience in specialized area of enrichment classes being offered, i.e. chess, cooking, pottery, etc.

High School Diploma or G.E.D.

Must be at least 18 years of age

Verbal & written communication skills in English and a demonstrated ability to read and comprehend written/graphic and oral instructions

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS AFTER HIRE
Proof of immunity to rubeola (measles) and rubella (German measles), or proof of MMR immunization

FBI fingerprint background check (at employee's expense).

Provides after and/or out of school age appropriate program enrichment classes in field of expertise in a non-core subject such as pottery, cooking, photography, or life skills.

Adapts teaching methods and instructional materials to meet students' varying needs and interests.

Prepares materials and classrooms for class activities.

Instructs and monitors students in use and care of equipment and materials, in order to prevent injury and/or damage.

Adheres to all court orders, state and federal laws, and District policies and regulations.

MENTAL **TASKS**
Communicating. Requires the ability to evaluate written material. Reads.

PHYSICAL TASK
Work involves the performance of duties where physical exertion is not normally required to perform all aspects of the job. Assistance is available as required to perform physically demanding tasks. Work involves sitting for extended periods of time, requires moving from one location to another, reaching, stooping, bending, and holding and grasping objects. Visual weakness must not prohibit the performance of assigned duties. Verbal communicative ability may be required of public contact positions.
