

Swim Lessons Instructor

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

Under the supervision of the Aquatics Specialist, the swim instructor teaches classes ranging from preschool to adults.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Certification in CPR and first aid a plus, but will be required once hired. Classes will be offered through employment. Previous experience preferred, but not required. Must be comfortable in the water and have knowledge of basic swim skills. Must have a good rapport with children and a sincere interest in the development of participants. Must be 14 years old or older. (14 – 15 year olds need a workers permit).

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Preparation and teaching of diving lessons including lessons plans.
2. Responsible for the upkeep and storage of instructional materials. .
3. Keep accurate records and submit individual assessments.
4. Attend regular trainings and staff meetings.
5. Light cleaning duties as assigned.
6. Teach private swim lessons.
7. Communicate effectively with parents, patrons and participants.
8. Teach private swim lessons.
9. Communicate effectively with parent, patrons, and participants.
10. Any other duties assigned by the Aquatics Specialist.

PHYSICAL EFFORT AND WORK ENVIRONMENT:

1. Must have a high comfort level of being in the swimming pool.
2. Must enjoy working with the public.
3. Must have the ability to work indoors/outdoors under various weather and environmental conditions.
4. Must have the ability to swim basic swim strokes.
5. Must be able to physically respond quickly in an emergency and stay calm in stressful situations.
6. Must be alert at all times, keeping safety in mind.
7. May be required to sit, stand, or maintain physical activity for extended periods of time.
