

SEASONAL PARK SANITATION WORKER

Number of Positions: 1

Dates: May 2nd – October 9th (Thursday – Sunday)

GENERAL DESCRIPTION/ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

This full-time seasonal position requires some skilled and unskilled work in the trash removal, custodial maintenance and general repair and maintenance of the District's picnic areas, playgrounds, shelters, hard courts, ball diamonds, restrooms and other facilities. Supervision is received from Supervisor of Facilities Maintenance or Superintendent of Planning and Operations.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Ability to perform a variety of tasks. Ability to understand the work from written and/or oral instructions. Ability to use and maintain tools in a safe manner. Hold and maintain a current driver's license. Must be at least 18 years of age, and provide satisfactory personal references.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Empty trash barrels and pick up trash from grounds.
2. Clean restrooms and restock necessary supplies.
3. Clean and set up pavilions and shelters.
4. Sweep walks and hard courts.
5. Janitorial in any of the Park District's facilities.
6. Follow daily vehicle maintenance schedule: check fluids, tires, etc.
7. Clean and maintain vehicles: wash and wax.
8. Other duties as assigned.

PHYSICAL EFFORT AND WORK ENVIRONMENT:

The incumbent performs a majority of duties outdoors seasonally and must be able to work effectively in sometimes extreme conditions. Ability to physically perform the essential duties of the position, including exerting sustained physical effort, bending, reaching, crouching/kneeling, standing/walking, for long periods, pushing/pulling/lifting/carrying objects weighing more than 50 pounds, handling/grasping/fingering objects, hearing sounds/communication, close and far vision.
