<b>Job Purpose</b>	The School Nurse along with the Health Services Coordinator helps students attain an optimum level of physical, social and emotional health. In order to coordinate a comprehensive student health program, the School Nurse must work closely with the District Nurse Coordinator, staff and administration of the district.

<b>Required Qualifications</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bachelor's of Science in Nursing</li> <li>• Registered Nurse License</li> <li>• Prior experience working with children preferred in a special needs school setting preferred, but not required</li> </ul>
<b>Physical Requirements &amp; Conditions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Running, walking, sitting, standing</li> <li>• Pushing and/or pulling; climbing and balancing, reaching forward and overhead, stooping, kneeling, crouching, crawling</li> </ul>
<b>Essential Job Functions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Establish and maintain a comprehensive health program for students</li> <li>• Conduct student health appraisals, including vision, and hearing screenings</li> <li>• Consult with teachers and parents regarding the health of students</li> <li>• Coordinate a program of communicable disease control based on Kansas immunization laws</li> <li>• Provide faculty and staff with first-aid training and supplies</li> <li>• Assist in providing emergency care for accidents and sudden illness of pupils until parents assume responsibility</li> <li>• Notify parents and building administrators regarding children who are severely ill or injured</li> <li>• Enforce and monitor medication guidelines</li> <li>• Coordinate and supervise a comprehensive program of dental health</li> </ul>

- Encourage parents to provide their children with annual dental check-ups
- Request assistance for dentally indigent children
- Coordinate and supervise a comprehensive program of health education
- Assist in planning health curriculum and instructional materials
- Maintain a cumulative health folder for each student, recording all data pertinent to the child's health
- Submit accurate and timely reports as required by various health agencies
- Immediately report any safety hazards or unsanitary conditions observed in the school environment
- Adhere to all district and cooperative health and safety policies, including all precautions of the Bloodborne Pathogens Exposure Control Plan
- Other duties as assigned by the Principal or Health Services Coordinator
