Position Summary

The School Psychologist provides assessment and interpretation to determine eligibility in accordance with NJAC 6A:14 and identifies learning, developmental, and adjustment characteristics in students. The psychologist evaluates environmental factors that may impact learning and adjustment and uses assessment data to develop appropriate interventions and programs. Responsibilities include providing direct interventions to support teaching and maximize student learning, offering consultation to parents, teachers, and staff, and assisting in the planning, development, and evaluation of programs to address identified needs. The psychologist delivers a comprehensive and coordinated program of psychological services, applying professional ethics and standards of practice while observing relevant laws and district policies. This role also requires maintaining ongoing professional growth, demonstrating effective communication with students, families, and staff, and performing related duties as assigned.

Qualifications

Valid New Jersey School Psychologist certification.

Demonstrated knowledge of psychological assessment tools, intervention strategies, and special education regulations.

The successful candidate is required to reside in New Jersey within one year of employment.
