Program Overview

FLIGHT (Fun, Learning, Inspiring, Growth, Helping, Together) is a before and after school care program designed to provide a safe, engaging, and supportive environment for students during out-of-school hours. The program aims to foster academic support, social-emotional learning, enrichment opportunities, and community connection.

Position Summary

The FLIGHT Site Coordinator is responsible for the day-to-day management of the Middle/High School FLIGHT program site. This role includes supervising staff, coordinating activities, ensuring a safe and welcoming environment, snack distribution and tracking, and maintaining effective communication with students, families, school personnel, and the FLIGHT Program Director. Each school site will have a dedicated Site Coordinator to meet the unique developmental needs of the age group served.

Key Responsibilities

- Oversee the daily operations of the FLIGHT program at the assigned school site (Middle/High School).
- Provide on-site leadership and support for program staff including activity leaders, aides, and volunteers.
- With the FLIGHT Director, develop, implement, and manage age-appropriate daily schedules, activities, and enrichment opportunities.
- Ensure the safety and supervision of all students at all times.
- Serve as the primary contact for families at the site, handling communications, inquiries, and concerns in a timely and professional manner.

- Collaborate with school personnel and the FLIGHT Director to align programming with school culture and academic goals.
- Maintain accurate attendance records, incident reports, snack distribution tracking, and other documentation as required.
- Monitor program supplies and equipment; submit purchase requests as needed.
- Support staff training and ongoing development; assist with onboarding of new team members.
- Uphold and model the values of FLIGHT including respect, responsibility, inclusion, and learning.

Qualifications

- Minimum of 2 years of experience working with school-age children in an educational or out-of-school time setting.
- Experience in a leadership or supervisory role preferred.
- Strong organizational and communication skills.
- Ability to manage multiple responsibilities and adapt to changing circumstances.
- CPR and First Aid certification (or willingness to obtain upon hire).
- Background check clearance required.

Preferred Skills and Attributes

- Passion for youth development and education.
- Ability to lead a team with positivity and accountability.
- Creative and resourceful in designing engaging and age-appropriate programming.
- Familiarity with child development principles relevant to either elementary or adolescent populations.
- Bilingual abilities a plus.
