

In December 2021, the Board of Education approved the following supplemental one-time stipends that apply every year.

Teachers with a ***valid teaching license*** hired in these roles receive the first half in December (or first paycheck if hired post-winter break) and the second half in June.

\$3,000: High School Physics

\$2,500: Special Education Teachers in Life Skills and IMHP and Grades 7 and 8 Math

\$2,000: Special Education Resource Grades 5-8; High School Math and Chemistry; and Grades 5 and 6 Math

Effective May 21, 2025, the following will provide up to \$10,000 in stipends over 2 years for ***middle school*** ELA and Math thus superseding the above \$2,500 stipend (temporarily):
