Title: **Teacher**

Function: To provide and guide learning experiences in order to advance positive pupil

growth and development to meet students needs in accordance with district

policies, goals, and course guides.

Reports to: Principal or his/her designee

Supervises: Students and assigned auxiliary personnel

Duties, responsibilities, and authorities:

A. Planning:

1. Assess the accomplishments of students on an ongoing basis.

- 2. Diagnose the learning needs of students on a continuing basis.
- 3. Follow the goals of the prescribed curriculum when writing lesson plans.
- 4. Utilize test data.
- 5. Report recognized student's special needs to appropriate school personnel.

B. Instruction:

- 1. Utilize a variety of styles and approaches which relate to achievement of curricular goals and objectives.
- 2. Provide learning experiences which are designed to meet the individual needs of students.
- 3. Provide learning experiences which are designed to reinforce basic skills.
- 4. Create a classroom environment that promotes mutual respect, positive attitudes, self discipline, and a sense of responsibility; and assist in extending that environment to the whole school.
- 5. Relate learning experiences with student's level of career development.
- 6. Make students aware of school and classroom rules and regulations, and maintain order as consistent with each learning experience.
- 7. Be aware of and, when the teacher deems appropriate, use district and community resources.

C. General professional behavior:

1. Remain abreast of current developments, new trends, research, contemporary interpretations of subject matter content, and teaching methodology in assigned area(s).

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- 2. Participate and cooperate with other staff and community members to reach district goals.
- 3. Attend staff meetings.
- 4. Maintain records and provide reports on students' progress as required.
- 5. Behave in accordance with the law and exhibit high standards of professional ethical behavior.
- 6. Follow district and school policies, regulations and procedures.
- 7. Perform duties assigned by the principal and/or his/her designee in accordance with law, policies and contract.

D. Professional preparation:

- 1. A bachelor's degree is required.
- 2. The applicant must hold, or be eligible for the appropriate certificate issued by the New Jersey State Department of Education.

E. Experience/Background:

Evidence of the characteristics of understanding, sensitivity, knowledge, and skill needed to be a classroom teacher.

F. Personal qualifications:

- 1. Must be mature and possess integrity.
- 2. Must be able to work successfully with pupils, other staff members, and administrators.
- 3. Must have the ability to communicate effectively with members of the community.
