Job Summary:

- Coach and instruct all student-athletes in proper fundamental skills, constantly improving technical skill levels, enabling the student-athlete to compete against all opponents.

Essential Functions:

- Policies and regulations of the Wyalusing Area School District (WASD) and the Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association (PIAA) are enforced
- Obtain all necessary coaching education and certifications prior to the start of each season
- Assist with the supervision of student-athletes at all practices, contests, and any other team functions
- Coach is knowledgeable in the sport and prepares the team at the junior varsity level
- Create positive and appropriate interpersonal relationships with the athletes
- Assist with the preparation for practices and contests
- Decide personnel in an objective manner and have full control of the junior varsity team
- Assist with managing team equipment and apparel
- Be cooperative in sharing and safeguarding facilities
- Be a positive role model for student-athletes
- Perform tasks to support the head coach and program as a whole
- Inform students-athletes and parents of all required policies, such as grade eligibility, athlete paperwork, school attendance, school discipline, etc.
- Communicate with the Athletic Trainer and be respectful to the decisions made in regard to return to play following an injury
- Assist in field preparation and maintenance
- Work professionally with all relevant stakeholders including but not limited to WASD administration, high school teaching staff, students, parents, community members, officials, etc.

- Effective colleague, parent and student communication skills.
- Problem-solving skills and technology proficiency.
