POSITION TITLE: School/District Interventionist

TITLE OF SUPERVISOR: Superintendent/School Administrator

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

To support the Yazoo County School District's instructional programs to ensure academic improvement, student growth, and continued success; henceforth, the focus of the position is on formulating, implementing, and progress monitoring instructional interventions at Tier II and Tier III of the Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS) for struggling students and teacher support

SALARY: Salary is reflective of the Yazoo County School District salary schedule

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Education/Certification:

- Bachelor's Degree in Education
- Valid Mississippi Teacher Certification appropriate for position

Special Knowledge/Skills:

- Knowledge of curriculum, design, and implementation
- Knowledge of state curriculum and assessments
- Ability to interpret data and assess instruction programs
- Ability to develop and deliver training and support classroom teachers
- Strong organizational, communication, and interpersonal skills
- Ability to adhere to timelines, time constraints, and large caseloads

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:

1. Works with individual students and student groups to provide effective interventions to improve student performance;
2. Support classroom instruction through modeling and mentoring, and providing support;
3. Facilitate campus screenings and assist with all other state and local assessments as needed;
4. Review student data with classroom teachers and assist in determining appropriate tiered intervention;

5. Set reasonable and realistic goals and time frames for interventions formulated for students;
6. Formulate behavior interventions for students in an effort to decrease undesired behavior that is hindering academic success;
7. Assist classroom teachers in determining and implementing appropriate tiered intervention.
8. Serve as a member of the school site (MTSS) committee;
9. Work with school site in the developing and implementing effective intervention programs;
10. Assist classroom teacher and any classroom paraprofessional in the delivery of district-wide instructional initiatives;
11. Confer with school administrators and district administrators concerning instructional implementations, concerns, and/or issues;
12. Confer with parents in terms of rate of progress or lack of progress in responding to interventions and mastering standards;
13. Assist with coordinating campus and district efforts to improve instruction for each child;
14. Facilitate, participate and provide campus and district professional development;
15. Work with school administrators to create a collaborative team to strengthen the instructional program of the school and district

Additional Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Other tasks as may be deemed appropriate and necessary by the immediate supervisor, the school administrator and/or the Superintendent
