- Assess barriers to the education of students and collaborate to resolve them

- Develop customized study schedules and strategies for students
- Encourage students to become active learners and class participants
- Teach effective note-taking techniques during lectures and other learning sessions
- Guide students in developing strong study skills and academic habits
- Conduct weekly meetings with assigned students and maintain thorough case notes
- Meet quarterly with the administrative team to review student progress and address any ongoing issues
- Lead and facilitate small-group study sessions
- Perform additional duties as assigned by administration
